This is a written request, pursuant to the state open records law, Tex. March 01, 2006 through May 31, 2006

As provided by the open records law, I will expect your response within ten (10) days. If you believe this information is not public, I ask that you immediately notify me and then seek a formal decision from the Texas Attorney General not later than ten (10) calendar days from your receipt of this request, as required by the open records law.

As a representative of the media I believe that disclosure of this information is in the public interest. By its very nature, the information requested (Public Information Charges) is in the public interest and providing a copy of the requested information will primarily benefit the general public. As a service to the public, this information may be distributed/published and made readily available free of charge. I therefore request a waiver of all fees and charges pursuant to Section 552.267 of the act.
