Media Advisory For Immediate Release

On March 9, 2008 at approximately 10:42 pm the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office received a call for service from the Bentwater Guard Station. The Caller stated that a male came to the guard shack, for help after being shot. Officers with the Montgomery Police Department were the first to arrive on scene and learned the following information from the security officer who was on duty. A white male, later identified as Matthew John Glaser came to the guard shack after being shot. Glaser told officers that Brian Turley fired several shots at him. There were numerous bullet holes in Mr. Glaser's vehicle. PHI Air Ambulance transported Mr. Glaser to Memorial Hermann Hospital in Houston, Texas where he is listed in critical condition.

At approximately 11:14 pm, the same date, the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office received another call for service from a female, who stated that Brian Turley had shot himself. Sheriff's Deputies responded to Star Violet Ct in The Woodlands where they learned that Brian Turley had arrived at this address unannounced. Turley told the resident that he had just shot at someone coming from his estranged wife's residence and that he did not know if he had hit the person. Mr. Turley then demanded the resident's car keys, but his friend refused. Mr. Turley then produced a handgun and shot himself one time in the head. Mr. Turley was transported to The Woodlands Memorial Hospital where he was pronounced dead.

Detectives were called to both scenes, and from the shell casings, it appears that, the same handgun was used at both scenes. This case is still under investigation at this time. Anyone with information is asked to call the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office Detective Division or Montgomery County Crime Stoppers.
