

SWORN COMPLAINT BEFORE THE TEXAS ETHICS COMMISSION

An individual must be a resident of the state of Texas to be eligible to file a sworn complaint with the Texas Ethics Commission. The complainant is required to attach to the complaint a copy of one of the following documents:

- complainant's driver's license or personal identification certificate issued under Chapter 521 of the Transportation Code, or commercial driver's license issued under Chapter 522 of the Transportation Code; or
- a utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows the name and address of the complainant and is dated not more than 30 days before the date on which the complaint is filed.

Effective September 1, 2009, an individual may also be eligible to file a sworn complaint with the Texas Ethics Commission if the individual owns real property in the state of Texas. Under this provision, the complainant will be required to attach to the complaint a copy of a property tax bill, notice of appraised value, or other government document that shows the name of the complainant, shows the address of the real property in Texas, and identifies the complainant as the owner of the real property.

The Texas Ethics Commission has jurisdiction to enforce only the following laws: (1) Title 15 of the Election Code; (2) Chapters 302, 303, 305, 572, 2004 of the Gov't Code; (3) § 334.025 and § 335.055 of the Local Gov't Code; (4) Subchapter C, Chapter 159 of the Local Gov't Code, in connection with a county judicial officer who elects to file a financial statement with the commission; (5) § 2152.064 and § 2155.003 of the Gov't Code; (6) § 306.005 of the Gov't Code.

C/OH Campaign Finance Report (30th day) - 4/03/08

1) Reported an incorrect "Contribution Balance". After adjusting for in-kind contributions (\$0.00), the contribution balance should be \$231.82, and not \$340.32, as reported, in violation of Section 254.031(a)(8). In the alternative, if the contribution balance is correct, the candidate failed to report additional political contributions, in violation of Section 254.031(a)(1),(6).

C/OH Campaign Finance Report (8th day) - 5/01/08

1) Reported an incorrect "Contribution Balance". After adjusting for in-kind contributions (\$0.00), the contribution balance should be <\$923.97>, and not \$1,030.23, as reported, in violation of Section 254.031(a)(8). In the alternative, if the contribution balance is correct, the candidate failed to report additional political contributions, in violation of Section 254.031(a)(1),(6).

2) Reported an outstanding loan without providing any loan detail, in violation of Section 254.031(a)(2).

3) Failed to timely report a political contribution (2 places), in violation of Section 254.031. Note that the listed contributions were not disclosed on previous reports.
